Beatson's Building Supplies Mull Rally weekend – 13th - 14th October 2018

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our plans for the 2018 Mull Rally weekend, which is somewhat similar to 2018 – i.e. two events are being planned by the Mull Rally Guardians / Mull Car Club (in association with Saltire Rally Club):

- A Targa & Historic Road Rally – on Saturday 13th October;
- A Rally Time Trial – on Sunday 14th October.

First of all, it's important to stress that there will be no road closures this year. All competitive action will take place on private roads and the public roads shall remain open throughout. However, the public roads will be used as transit between the competitive tests, and this letter provides an outline schedule for their use. On the public roads, competing cars are required to drive courteously and with the flow of traffic. You may experience a slightly higher volume of traffic.
